Per Virginia ABC law, no outside alcohol may be brought to, or consumed on, Winton's property. However, if you like to enjoy an adult beverage while on the course, we have beer for sale in the pro shop and we even have complimentary coolers available to make sure your drinks stay cold for all 18 holes!

If Winton is ever found to be in violation of this regulation, the property would lose its ABC license. We don't want to see that happen, so we appreciate the cooperation of all members with this regulation.

## Recipe of the Month: BEER BRAISED BRATS WITH ONIONS

### Ingredients

1 package of bratwurst	1-2 tbsp brown sugar
1 onion, sliced	Hot dog buns
Dab of butter	Spicy mustard
1 dark beer	

### Instructions

Preheat the grill.

Grill bratwurst until they are done, around 20 minutes.

While they are cooking, melt butter in a good size pot.

Add onions and sauté until they start to get soft.

Add brown sugar (**use a little more if your onion is large; use a little less if your onion is medium/small**) and stir to combine.

Add cooked bratwurst.

Pour in your beer of choice and bring to a simmer. Allow to simmer for 20-30 minutes, or until you are ready to eat.

Fill bun with bratwurst, top with mustard and onions.
