

Winton Country Club Pool Rules



1. The Pool Manager, Lifeguards, and General Manager are responsible for conduct in the pool area. Their instructions must be followed at all times. The Pool Manager and the General Manager are authorized to suspend pool privileges for conduct which violates pool rules.
2. All primary Club members are responsible for members who are registered under their Club membership.
3. All members are required to register each time they use the pool. This needs to be done with the lifeguard. The lower gate will be for Lifeguard use only.
4. Winton Country Club Pool Guest Policy:
 - All guests must be accompanied by a member.
 - NON-RESIDENT GUEST – A non-resident guest is one who resides more than thirty five (35) miles from the Club. A \$10 weekly guest pass is required for each out of town guest (above the age 2).
 - RESIDENT GUEST – A resident guest is one who resides within 35 miles of the Club. The charge for resident guests shall be \$6 for adults and \$3 for children. Members must sign a guest ticket. Resident guests are limited to six (6) pool visits, regardless of host membership. Guest fees after 4:00pm are \$3 for adults and \$2 for children (2-18) no exceptions.
 - BABY-SITTERS – A member requiring a full-time babysitter for their children must submit a letter to the pool manager in advance for approval. There will be a fee of \$3 collected per visit (or season pass of \$30) – no exceptions. Season pass is not a membership to Winton Country Club, it only allows babysitter access while with the members' children. A record of babysitter names will be kept on file.
 - Members MUST register all guests when entering, sign a guest ticket if there is a charge, and report such guests to a Lifeguard. Please familiarize your guests with the pool rules.
5. Children under the age of twelve (12) must be accompanied by someone of at least sixteen (16) years of age at pool-side and must be watched carefully. Our Lifeguards are not baby sitters. Persons designated to accompany children under 12 must register themselves and the children at the pool entrance (please see rules three and four.)
6. Jumping over the Pool fences to enter or exit the Pool is strictly PROHIBITED. Immediate suspension from the Pool and Winton Country Club and Golf Course, Inc., will result from the time of the INFRACTION of this rule. The suspension would be in effect for the remainder of the Pool season. NO employee of Winton Country Club, member or guest can give permission for anyone to climb or jump over the Pool fencing. All persons must enter and exit through the designated door and gate openings.
7. Boisterous or Indecent conduct, rough games, running, shoving, etc., will not be permitted. Profanity is strictly prohibited. Continued violation may result in suspended pool privileges.
8. Safety instructions issued by our Club Management, Pool Manager, Head Lifeguard or Lifeguards to a Club member or guest for their protection should be given immediate adherence.
9. No pets are allowed in the pool area.
10. Food is restricted to the upper deck and is not permitted in the pool area. No glass of any sort is permitted in the pool area, however, soft drinks in cans or paper cups are allowed. No smoking will be permitted in the Pool House.
11. Member and guest are responsible for areas you use while at the Pool. All refuse and waste papers must be deposited in designated receptacles.

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12. Rafts and swimming rings are not permitted in the pool. Floating devices must be cleared by a Lifeguard. Skates or similar equipment are not allowed in the pool area. Only Nerf balls are allowed in pool area. Water guns, pistols or rifles are not allowed.
13. Only one (1) person is allowed on the diving board at a time. Diving from the side of the board is not permitted. Continued violation may result in suspended pool privileges.
14. A limited number of chairs will be available for members' use on a first come basis.
15. Pool parties must first be cleared with the General Manager and/or Pool Manager and then arranged with the Pool Manager.
16. Parties must be arranged at least two weeks in advance so that a Lifeguard can be on duty as needed.
17. Alcoholic beverages at the pool must be purchased at the Winton Country Club Pro Shop. All guests must show their receipt from the Pro Shop upon entering the pool or alcoholic beverages will be confiscated.
18. The Lifeguards room is reserved for use by the Pool Staff. Only authorized personnel are allowed in that part of the Pool House.
19. Winton Country Club is not responsible for any loss of property or any personal injury suffered by any member or guest.
20. These rules may be changed from time to time by the Winton Board of Directors. The Board reserves the right to suspend rules for special occasions if the need arises. Any such changes will be posted.
21. No Smoking is allowed inside the fence and the entire Pool complex.
22. Persons with open wounds or infections may not enter the pool.
23. Swim diapers are mandatory for children 2 years or under, or until they are completely toilet trained. This is for the health and safety of all swimmers.
24. Rain checks for guests will be provided if inclement weather occurs before a 2-hour visit is over. After 2 hours, no rain checks will be issued.
